Curbside Pickup May Help Public After Storms

FREDERICK, MD – July 11, 2018: City residents who have water-damaged goods may find it useful to reserve a time for the Sanitation Department to pick up bulk items at the curb.

“The once-per-year free service that we started this year may be particularly helpful,” said Mayor Michael O’Connor.

Items acceptable for pickup:

- furniture
- appliances
- bicycles
- large toys
- swing sets
- mattress and box
- springs (3 per household)
- mowers*
- weed cutters*
- trimmers*
- grills (tanks removed)
- electronics
- monitors
- televisions

*fluids removed

Free curbside pickup of bulk items (see list of acceptable items) is available by reservation once per year, and additional pickups may be reserved for a fee.

The Sanitation Department will make every effort to expedite the collection, since recent storms may have resulted in a need to dispose of items.
