# Storm Clean-up Guidance, Damage Prevention

**FREDERICK, MD – July 22, 2019:** A severe storm with high winds that swept through parts of Frederick City July 21 downed trees and tree limbs that will take some time to clean up.

- **Debris on Your Property:** Any storm debris that is on private property, please cut to less than 6 feet in length, and bundle and put out for yard waste collection on your normal trash collection day.
- **Utility Wires:** If you notice downed wires entangled with trees or tree limbs, do not touch. Contact [Potomac Edison](#), 1-888-LIGHTSS, to report the issue.

The City continues to receive reports of downed trees and tree limbs. City crews will be working over the next several days to clean up from the storm, and we remind you to exercise caution when passing crews on City streets.

### How to help

- **Prevent flooding:** With the heavy rain that is forecast, the City is also requesting your assistance in making sure storm drain intakes in your area are free of debris.
- **Reporting damage/roads blocked:** To report fallen trees on City property or roads, the number to call is 301-600-1440.
- **Report downed wires** to [Potomac Edison](#), 1-888-LIGHTSS, and do not touch them.
