POLICE REPORT:

Sgt. Greg Stocksdale addressed public safety concerns and shared NAC3-area statistics, which are listed at the end of these Minutes. He reminded residents to please call the police if they see anything suspicious. Sgt. Stocksdale talked about the following specific issues:

- Crumland Farms had some tools taken and this is still an open case
- Please remember to lock your car doors – all the thefts from motor vehicles in NAC 3 were from unlocked cars.
- Reminder that there is no dumping at the end of Christophers Crossing. Folks have been dumping furniture and other materials back there

A resident asked Sgt. Stocksdale to check on some spray paint that is on the sidewalk on Beaver Creek lane by Monocacy Middle. There are 3 initials spray painted.

PLANNING:

Matt Davis from the Planning Department was on hand to talk about 2 re-zoning projects. The first was the area where the proposed water tower will be placed. It is currently Institutional.

The other project was the Sanner Property to be rezoned to accommodate a future fire station

GUEST SPEAKERS:

Cpl. Vince Brown – Frederick Police Department Drug Enforcement Unit, Heroin Presentation

Cpl. Brown was on hand to do a presentation on heroin. The presentation included what it looks like, what the effects are, why it is so addictive, how it is ingested, and why it has become so popular. He also talked about the department's response to this such as education, outreach, and treating each scene (overdose, etc.) as a crime scene to go after those who sell this stuff. Cpl. Brown also distributed information about a program offered by the Health Department. This program is for community members who are interested in overdose prevention. If you have a loved one at risk for a heroin overdose or prescription pain medication, this training will teach you how to:

- The types of Opioids
- How to recognize, respond, and prevent an Opioid overdose as well as how to administer intra-nasal naloxone
- Right and responsibilities for those who choose to receive a prescription for naloxone
- Resources for Family Members, Friends & Loved Ones

Lori was on hand to talk to residents about Charter Government. The Primary is on June 24th.

Here is the breakdown for the Legislative Branch:

County Council:	7 member body, 5 elected by district, 2 elected at large.
Term:	4 year term, can serve no more than 3 consecutive terms
Salary:	\$22,500
Council Meetings:	limited to 45 days per year. Council can meet in non-legislative sessions as needed

Here is the breakdown for the Executive Branch:

County Executive:	The Executive is the chief officer of the county who directs, supervises, and oversees the administration of all executive departments, agencies, and offices
Term:	4 year term, can serve no more than 2 consecutive terms.
Salary:	\$95,000

The Charter was approved in 2012. The provisions of the charter take effect on December 1, 2014, when the first County Executive and members of the first County Council take office following their election in November 2014.
