Description: The subject property of 4.13 acres, Lot 10RB, is zoned M1 Light Industrial. The newly created Lot

10R-B is proposed for a Marriott hotel, 6 stories in height. The hotel will have auto charging stations and state of art microtubines to supplement heating and cooling operations in the hotel. The hotel has planned for 118 rooms. The tentative Planning Commission date is April 9, 2018.

GUEST SPEAKERS:

• Cherian Eapen – Traffic Engineer, City of Frederick City will be starting on Sanner piece of Christopher's Crossing could start March of this year, should be completed in

2 years. Soon there will be no more parking on Thomas Johnson. Notice will be given to businesses letting them

know. There will be a new signal at TJ and Christophers Crossing, there is no current timeframe for it to be installed. The interim arrangement will be to have a 4 way stop sign.

Christophers Crossing – to make 2 lanes - the best option is to move the curb back and adjust median. The signal costs about 300-350k. City has to decide if it will be funded by the developer or by the city.

Are there any plans for speed control on Christophers Crossing? City will be looking at lowering speed limit. Currently it is 35 mph, possibly lowering to 25 or 30 mph. Residents are concerned due to increased traffic that will be coming through there when bridge opens up. Cherian said that he does not see any new traffic control measures other than lowering the speed. Cherian will also work with FCPS to possibly move school pickups from Christophers Crossing. Cpl. Alger talked about traffic enforcement in the area and enhanced measures.

FCC Crosswalk

Cherian as well as other city employees looked at crosswalk, concern is that it is challenging to cross. From a signal standpoint there is a sign that says yield to pedestrians in the crosswalk. The driver must yield to pedestrians at the crosswalk. A possible solution may be to give pedestrians a few seconds head start before the light turns green. Also looking at adding a crosswalk to Monocacy Middle from FCC. This would take some time. Can a NO TURN ON RED sign be added to CTC intersection?
