

## AREAS OF MINORITY/NONWHITE CONCENTRATION

The City of Frederick is 77% white and the remainder nonwhite or two or more races. 4.8% of City residents identified themselves as Hispanic. We have defined areas of racial/ethnic minority concentration as census tracts that have a greater percentage than 23% nonwhite and greater than 4.8% Hispanic. The census tracts are:

- 1) Census Tract 750300, 58.1% nonwhite (A traditionally African-American neighborhood concentrated on West All Saints and West South Streets since the 19th Century)
- 2) Census tract 750501, 41.7% nonwhite, 9.75% Hispanic (An area of a large concentration of aging garden apartments)
- 3) Census tract 750502, 30.4%, 5.7% Hispanic (An area of late 70s-early 80s townhouses and condominiums as well as garden apartments)
- 4) Census tract 750100, 31.8% (A less-gentrified area of the Downtown Historic District)
- 5) Census Tract 750900, 31.6% (Again, less gentrified historic areas with mixed commercial, retail, and industrial uses interspersed. Traditionally, the "industrial" part of Frederick).
