Yellow Springs Road and Christophers Crossing Roundabout Construction Will Begin June 18

FREDERICK, MD – The Frederick County Office of Transportation Engineering announced today that Yellow Springs Road and Christophers Crossing roundabout construction activities will begin on or about June 18, 2018. Flagging operations with one-lane closures will occur during the first two weeks of construction. The intersection at Yellow Springs Road and Christophers Crossing will be closed to through traffic on or about July 9, 2018. This will allow contractor Wastler & Son to complete the roundabout.

The intersection will be closed to all traffic from July 9, 2018, for approximately six weeks, and will reopen on or about August 20, 2018, weather permitting. The work includes grading, paving, and striping. Detour signs will be posted and variable message boards will be used to alert traffic of the closure. Local traffic will have access to Yellow Springs Road and Christophers Crossing via the detour route. The detour route will use Tuscanney Drive and Rocky Springs Road.
