Freecycle Roundup to Receive, Reuse Bulk Items *For City of Frederick Residents Only, Oct. 20*

FREDERICK, MD – Sept. 18, 2018: The next Freecycle Roundup serving The City of Frederick will be Saturday, Oct. 20, to receive and recycle the bulk items City residents no longer want to keep.

The Freecycle Roundup is an opportunity to drop off items at no cost and to reduce the amount of reusable items that end up in the Frederick County landfill. The Freecycle Roundup will operate 8 a.m.-2 p.m, Oct. 20, at the Public Works complex, 111, Airport Drive East, Frederick.

Notes about Freecycle Roundup:

1. For Frederick City residents only; they will need to bring identification that is proof of residency
2. Bulk items only; no bags of trash
3. NO Document shredding will be available
4. What can be dropped off
 - furniture, appliances – if all refrigerants are removed
 - box springs and mattresses – no more than three of each per household, must sign affidavit
 - exercise equipment
 - grills with fuel tanks removed
 - large televisions

The city organizes the Freecycle Roundup semiannually for residents so they can easily dispose of bulk items, and reusable items can be removed from the waste stream. Further information is available from Tammy Albaugh at talbaugh@cityoffrederick.com or 301-600-1680.

The next Freecycle Roundup will be held on Saturday, October 20 from 8am-2pm. This event provides City residents an opportunity to get rid of bulk items. Non-profit organizations will be on hand to take item donations. All items must be less than 7 feet in length.
