City to Issue Taxicab Permits

FREDERICK, MD – Oct. 31, 2017: The City of Frederick Taxicab Commission has six taxicab permits available.

To obtain a new taxicab permit, the applicant must submit to the Taxicab Administrative Agency, on or before Nov. 17, 2017:

- A City of Frederick Taxicab Permit Application
- A permit fee of \$2,500 in the form of a certified check (refundable only if permit is not granted)

Each applicant may submit one application and associated fee for each available permit. In the event that there is only six or fewer applicant(s), the eligible applicant(s) will be awarded the permit(s).

If there are more than six applicants, a lottery will be conducted on or before Dec. 1, 2017, in the Boardroom at City Hall, 101 N. Court St. The Taxicab Commission will choose the winners to receive the taxicab permits by a random drawing of names of eligible applicants. Once the winners are selected to receive a taxicab permit, the \$2,500 fee for that permit is nonrefundable.
