Airport Assistant Manager Earns Professional Accreditation

FREDERICK, MD – Nov. 8, 2017: Nicholas E. Sabo, A.A.E., assistant airport manager, Frederick Municipal Airport, Frederick, has been awarded the distinction of accredited airport executive by the American Association of Airport Executives (AAAE).

To qualify for his distinction, Sabo had to successfully complete three phases of the accreditation process: pass a 180-item multiple-choice examination, fulfill a writing requirement, and demonstrate, in the final interview by a panel of accredited airport executives, his knowledge of airport management, business administration, and general transportation economics.

“Sabo’s achievement attests to his ability to meet these stringent requirements and his experience in managing a public airport,” stated the AAAE.

By fulfilling all the requirements leading to the title of accredited airport executive, Sabo joins a select group of individuals who have earned the designation in the six plus decades of the accreditation program’s existence. At present, less than 10 percent of AAAE’s members throughout the country are active accredited airport executives.
