



Thanksgiving Changes Service Schedule; *Free Holiday Parking Begins on Nov. 23*

FREDERICK, MD – Nov. 14, 2017: The City of Frederick offices will be closed Nov. 23 and 24 in observance of Thanksgiving, and the holiday will cause a change in trash and yard waste collection.

The date also marks the start of free weekend holiday parking: Parking will be free at all City meters and parking decks on Thanksgiving day, Frosty Friday, Nov. 24, and the entire weekend. From 8 a.m., Saturday, to 6 a.m., Monday, every weekend, through New Year's day, parking will be free at all meters and in City parking decks.

REFUSE COLLECTION

Residential:

There will be no trash collection service on Thursday, Nov. 23, and normal Friday collection will move to Monday.

- If you normally set your household trash out on Wednesday evening for Thursday collection please set your trash out on Thursday evening for Friday collection.
- If you normally set your household trash out on Thursday evening for Friday collection please set your trash out on Sunday evening for Monday collection.
- All other trash collection will maintain regular schedule.

Commercial Business Trash Service:

Trash will be collected on normal schedule.

RECYCLING

Residential:

This schedule does not affect residential recycling. Please contact Frederick County Recycling with questions: 301-600-2960.

Commercial Business Recycling Service (not residential):

Recycling will not be collected Nov. 24, but will return to the normal schedule on Monday, Nov. 27.

Yard Waste Collection Services:

There will be no yard waste collection on Thursday, Nov. 23, or Friday, Nov. 24. Residents are asked to hold their yard waste until the next scheduled collection date.
