Community Garden Spaces Must Be Cleaned Out

FREDERICK, MD – Nov. 17, 2017: Anyone who reserved a community garden plot from The City of Frederick this year must clean it out by Dec. 4 to allow for mowing by the Parks Division staff.

Please remove any plant material and any and all other objects, such as fencing, trellis, pots, signs, tools, chairs and furniture. Please leave the City plot number signs in place. Any items left after Dec. 4 will be removed and discarded, and the plots mowed, unless the parks staff are notified before Dec. 4 that you intend to prepare plants for winter. Even if you plan to prepare vegetation for winter, your plot must be maintained: be clean and free of all trash, debris, and other items by Monday, Dec. 4, 2017.

Please note the waiver on the application form: The user shall be responsible for any and all loss, damage or injury to any and all personal property that it or its agents, representatives, invitees or guests, may bring to, store at, or leave at the facility and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of Frederick.

When contacting the City regarding your garden plot, please note the name under which the plot is reserved, plot number and location (Hargett or Willowbrook) and verify all your contact information.

Please note that for 2018, applications are to be submitted by the deadline of Feb. 28, 2018. Applications may be submitted beginning Feb. 1. Each plot will be inspected by city staff, and must pass inspection prior to being approved for a plot. Fees will be collected once you have been notified that you are approved for a plot. Please do not submit any fees with the application—a change from previous years.
