Christmas Tree Drop-Off, Recycling

FREDERICK, MD – Dec. 12, 2017: To conserve and recycle resources, the City of Frederick offers residents the opportunity to drop off their Christmas trees for recycling, Dec. 27, 2017, to Jan. 31, 2018.

Drop-off locations, beginning Dec. 27:

- Harry Grove Stadium lower parking lot
- Husky Park Yard 2 on Highland Street
- Tasker's Chance parking lot on Key Parkway behind Westridge Shopping Center
- Max Kehne parking lot on West Seventh Street

Each park will have a drop off area designated by a sign. Please make sure trees are free of all ornaments, garland, tinsel, lights, and/or tree stands. Please remove any plastic bags from around the trees.

As part of The City of Frederick's recycling efforts, Christmas trees are collected annually and ground into mulch. This effort conserves space in the landfill, and mulch has beneficial results:

- Soil temperature moderation
- Moisture/water retention
- Reduction of competition (weeds)
- Recycling of nutrients through decomposition
- Conserves city funds through a reduction of purchased mulch
