### Tax Credit for Historic Property Rehabilitation

*Jan. 16 Workshop to Instruct Property Owners*

**FREDERICK, MD – Jan. 2, 2018:** If you own a certified historic property in Maryland, you may have the opportunity to earn a state income tax credit on qualified rehabilitation expenditures.

You can learn about the Maryland Rehabilitation Tax Credit Program and opportunities that may be available to you at a free workshop, Jan. 16, 6 p.m. in **Conference Room C at the Municipal Annex Office Building.**

Whether you are planning to rehabilitate your primary or secondary residence or a commercial property, there are state incentives that may help. Rehabilitation projects include but are not limited to: painting, systems upgrades, roof replacement, window and door repair, and floor refinishing.
