Trash Collection Changes for MLK Holiday

FREDERICK, MD – Jan. 9, 2018: Because The City of Frederick will observe the Martin Luther King holiday on Monday, Jan. 15, 2018, trash collection schedules and parking fees will change as follows:

Parking

Parking will be free at meters and in city parking decks.

Trash

There will be no trash collection service on Monday. This notice applies to residents who normally set out their trash out on Sunday evening for Monday morning collection. These residents are asked to put their trash out on Monday evening after 5 p.m. for Tuesday collection. All other trash collection will be as usual for the week.

The Downtown Commercial District -- which includes Market Street from South Street to Seventh Street, and Patrick Street from East Street to Bentz Street -- will have trash collection as scheduled.

Recycling

There will be no recycling for the Downtown Commercial District. It will resume to the normal schedule on Wednesday, Jan. 17.

Yard Waste

There will be no yard waste collection for NAC Area 9 on Jan. 15. Yard waste will be collected on the next regular collection day.
